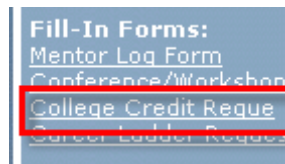
Using Wikis in Your Classroom 6/23/2009

Project Requirements

- ☐ You must use the template that is available on ITD webpage at <http://usd259sandbox.wikispaces.com> The rubric for grading the project can also be found on this page.
- ☐ Lesson plan is clearly connected to standards - The standards listed should indicate both the number of the standard and the description of the standard.
Example:
3rdGrade Reading 1.3.3
Standard 1: The student reads and comprehends text across the curriculum. Benchmark 3: The student expands vocabulary. Indicator 3: Identifies and uses synonyms, antonyms, and homophones to determine the meaning of words.
- ☐ Activity directions must be clear so that others can easily understand the lesson.
- ☐ Use consistent font, color, and formatting.
- ☐ Project should have:
 - ☐ An ad-free wiki created with Wikispaces with the following components:
 - Student accounts added to the wiki and have given appropriate permissions to the students.
 - A minimum of two student groups using the student accounts created.
 - An image added to the wiki page banner.
 - A minimum of three pages (the home page plus a minimum of two additional pages.)
 - A minimum of one discussion per page created.
 - ☐ A lesson plan implementing the wiki in the classroom and has the following components:
 - Completed lesson plan template from class (Can be found on wiki from class)
 - A letter to be sent home with the students informing them of the class/group wiki.
 - Clear evidence of how student collaboration and/or interaction will happen using the wiki.
- ☐ Include evidence of higher level questioning in posts.
- ☐ Project should be free of spelling, punctuation and grammar errors.

Each person is responsible for requesting college credit through My Learning Plan. To do this, you need to log in to My Learning Plan. Click on "College Credit Request" on the left side of the screen and fill out the required information.



Grade letters for each workshop will be mailed as soon as the grades are recorded. Only one workshop grade will appear on a grade letter.
